Over the past months, the FYI project has brought together young people from Bulgaria, Cyprus, Estonia, Slovakia and Slovenia to explore one big question: What kind of future do we want to create?

Through interactive workshops, creative discussions and foresight activities, participants imagined different futures, shared their ideas and discovered how today's choices can shape tomorrow.

What happened?

Young people across Europe had the chance to:

- develop solutions for more inclusive and sustainable communities

Most participants had never used foresight before—but by the end of the project they were thinking like future designers!





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What did we learn?

One message came through loud and clear:

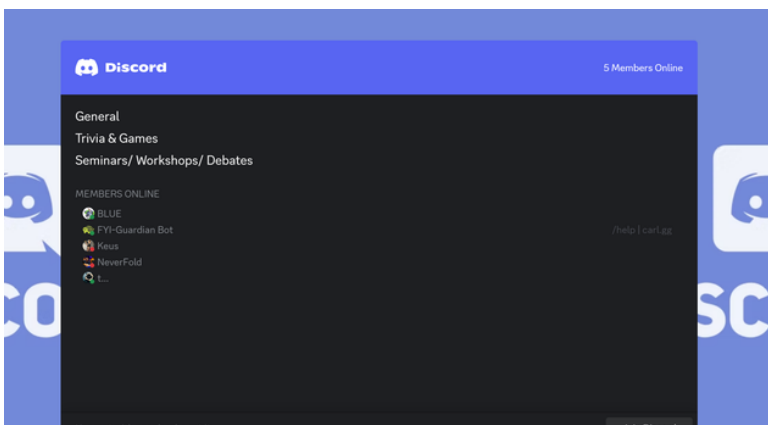
Young people want to be part of shaping the future—not just talking about it.

- Sustainability
- More opportunities for young people to have their voices heard

These ideas helped create the FYI Policy Recommendations, giving decision-makers a better understanding of what young people really need.
